Additionally, the international business school provides an interdisciplinary platform for discourse between politics, business, and academia. Our campus

The ESMT campus was inaugurated in 2006 in the former State Council building of the GDR, which once served as the official office of Erich Honecker. Located at the historic Schlossplatz, directly opposite the former City Palace, the building's facade prominently features a reproduction of Portal IV of the former Berlin City Palace.

It was from the balcony of this portal that Karl Liebknecht is said to have proclaimed the "free socialist republic" in 1918. Between 1999 and 2001, the building also served as the office of then Federal Chancellor Gerhard Schröder.

The State Council building was meticulously renovated by the ESMT Foundation to preserve its historic character while transforming it into a modern educational facility, maintaining much of the original interior architecture. From 2015 to 2017, ESMT further renovated and expanded sections of the building.

In 2024, ESMT Berlin received €6.8 million from the federal government's KulturInvest program to further modernize its campus within the former State Council building. The remaining estimated total cost of €14 million for the final modernization phase will be covered by donations.

The roof of the building houses a photovoltaic system that covers up to 25 percent of ESMT's electricity needs. With 893 high-efficiency modules and a total capacity of 366 kWp, it is the largest system of its kind in Berlin-Mitte.
