I. General notes

E-mail address (contact option for questions about the donation) c) Legal bases of the processing are: Art. 6 para. 1 a), b) and f) GDPR

¹ In order to claim a donation of up to EUR 300 for tax purposes, a "simplified donation receipt" will be provided in accordance with Section 50 (2) No. EStDV. You will find the simplified donation receipt, which contains all the required tax information here. Along with this donation receipt, a deposit slip or account statement should be included in your tax claim. For donations over EUR 300, you will receive a separate donation receipt from us, provided we have your address. Donations to recognized non-profit institutions, such as ESMT Berlin, are tax-deductible under Section 10b of the German Income Tax Act.

4. Recipients/categories of recipients	ESMT employees who are responsible for donations. External service providers used as subcontractors or to support administrative activities as part of the provision of services.
5. Duration of data storage	We delete data pursuant to Art. 17 (1) a) GDPR if we no longer need them for the purposes for which we collected and processed them. If the data is processed on the basis of consent and there is a revocation, we delete the data immediately; the same applies if a justified objection to processing has been filed. In the case of statutory retention obligations, deletion only comes into consideration after the expiry of the respective retention obligation.
6. Rights of the data subjects	As a data subject, you may exercise the following rights: Right of access, Art. 15 GDPR Right of rectification, Art. 16 GDPR Right to erasure, Art. 17 GDPR Right to restriction of processing, Art. 18 GDPR Right to data portability, Art. 20 GDPR Right to lodge a complaint with the competent data protection authority, Art. 77 GDPR. Right to withdraw consent given, Art. 7, para. 3 GDPR Right to object if personal data are processed on the basis of legal provisions due to legitimate interests according to Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 letter f) GDPR, Art. 21 GDPR Complaints related to data protection can be made to the supervisory authorities.
