Purpose and lawfulness of processing	<p>The purpose of the processing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Protection of the health of our employees, visitors, customers and service providers- Containment of a pandemic by tracing chains of infection- Compliance with legal regulations in force during the pandemic in accordance with the Ordinance on Measures Necessary to Stem the Spread of the Novel Coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19) of the Berlin Senate of 28 May 2020, § 2 <p>- Legal basis of the processing is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">o Art. 6 para. 1 lit. c) GDPRo Applicable version of the Ordinance on Measures Necessary to Stem the Spread of the Novel Coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19) of the Berlin Senate <p>- The following data will be processed: First and last name, full home address and email address, if available, as well as telephone number and district of residence, and time and duration of presence.</p>

4. Recipients/Categories of recipients	<p>The data will remain internal and will only be transferred to the health authority upon request.</p> <p>For the purposes of infection protection, the currently applicable legal regulations stipulate that we are obliged to provide information to the responsible health authorities. If your personal data is requested by the competent health authority, the latter is responsible for the further processing of your personal data.</p>
5. Duration of data storage	<p>The duration of the data storage is 2 weeks. After expiry of the retention period, the personal data will be erased.</p>
6. Rights of persons concerned (data subjects)	<p>As the person concerned (data subject), you can claim the following rights:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Right of access by the data subject, Art. 15 GDPR ○ Right to rectification, Art. 16 GDPR ○ Right to erasure ('right to be forgotten'), Art. 17 GDPR, if the legal requirements for this are met ○ Right to restriction of processing, Art. 18 GDPR, if the legal requirements for this are met ○ Right to data portability, Art. 20 GDPR ○ Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, Art. 77 GDPR. ○ Right to withdraw a given consent, Art. 7, para. 3 GDPR and if your personal data are processed on the legal basis of legitimate interests in accordance with Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 letter f) GDPR, <p>Complaints relating to data protection may be lodged with the supervisory authorities.
