TEDx conference on sustainable transformation at ESMT Berlin

On Saturday, February 4, 2023, ESMT Berlin students will host an independent TEDx conference for the third time. This year's theme is "Berlin: A driver of sustainable transformation?".

The speakers' talks will delve into questions about the capital of Germany as a catalyst for change. Why does Berlin need a strong vision to drive the mobility transformation? How can sustainable transformation challenges be achieved and tackled? What role must education play for positive change?

In the spirit of ideas worth spreading, TEDx is a program of local, self-organized events that bring people together to share a TED-like experience. At a TEDx event, TED Talks video and live speakers combine to spark deep discussion and connection. These local, self-organized events are branded TEDx, where x = independently organized TED event. The TED Conference provides general guidance for the TEDx program, but individual TEDx events are self-organized. (Subject to certain rules and regulations.)

About TED

TED is a nonprofit organization devoted to Ideas Worth Spreading, often in the form of short talks delivered by leading thinkers and doers. Many of these talks are given at TED conferences, intimate TED Salons and thousands of independently organized TEDx events around the world.
